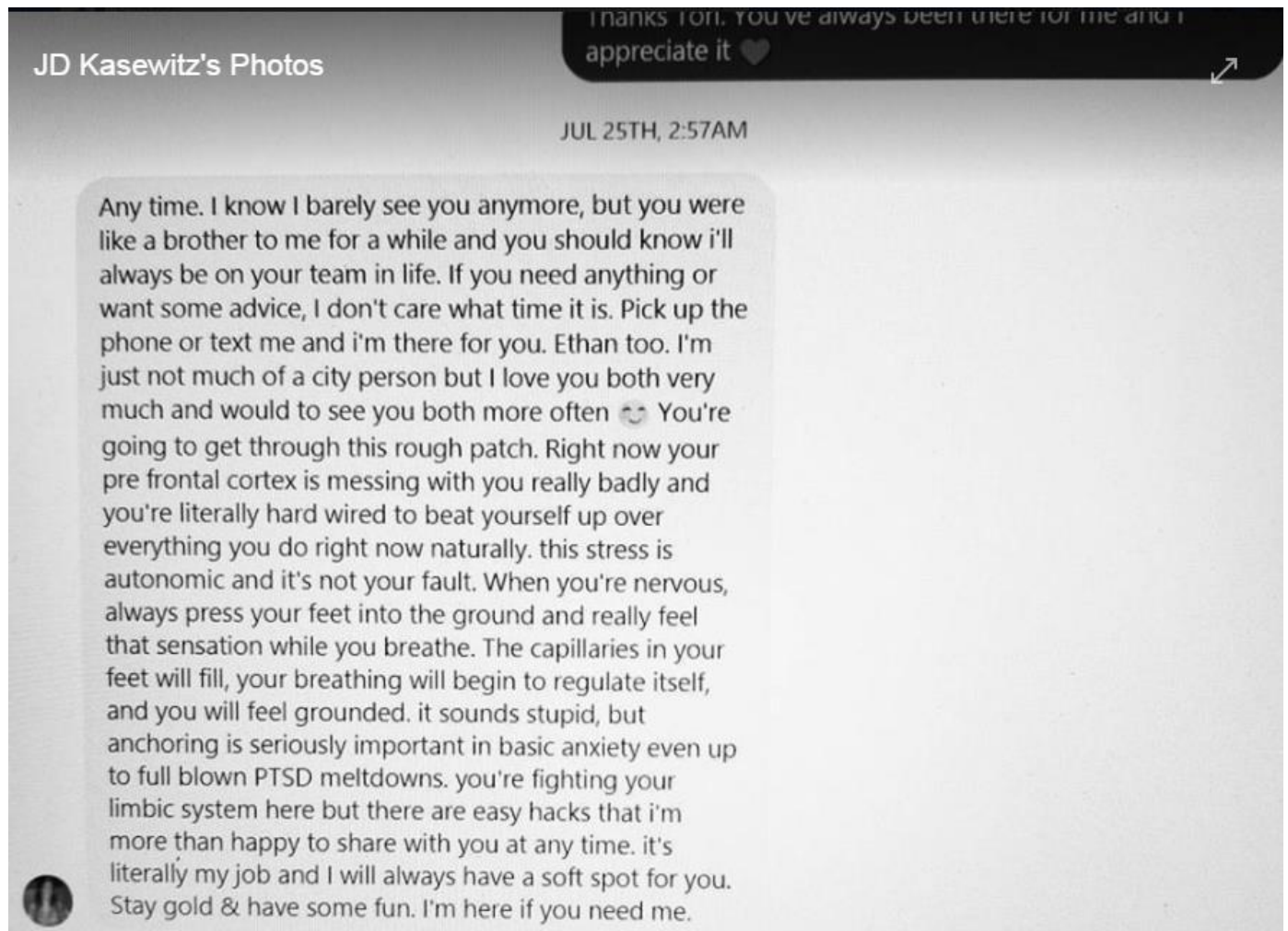
There isn't anything I can say to express how much this hurts.
